#### **AP** fee reductions

Learn about federal <u>eligibility</u> <u>criteria</u> for fee reductions for low-income students. <u>State-</u> <u>specific information</u> will be posted as soon as it becomes available.

#### Score reports

Encourage your students to sign up for a <u>free College</u> <u>Board account</u>. When ordering exams, make sure that the grade enrollment numbers you provide include all students in your school, not just AP students, to ensure accurate reporting.

#### Seating charts

All schools must complete a <u>seating chart</u> for every exam they administer.

#### **AP NARs**

A completed <u>AP</u> <u>Nonstandard</u> <u>Administration Report</u> (<u>NAR</u>) must be returned for each AP Exam taken with accommodations.

#### **Class sections**

**Designate section numbers** 

on students' answer sheets to get subject score rosters and AP Instructional Planning Reports at the class section or teacher level.
