

# AP<sup>®</sup> Spanish Literature and Culture Course and Exam Description Revisions

The *AP Spanish Literature and Culture Course and Exam Description* was updated in fall 2014, with minor changes intended to bring the curriculum framework and the AP Exam instructions into alignment. These changes were made to clarify that students may be asked to analyze texts in terms of genre, period, movement, or technique.

Please note the following corrections:

- The word *period(s)* added on pages 11 and 39.
