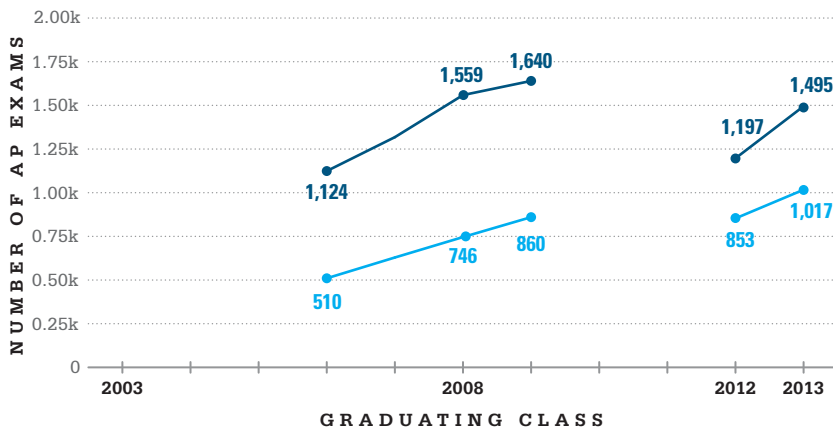

- Taken by graduates during high school scoring 3+

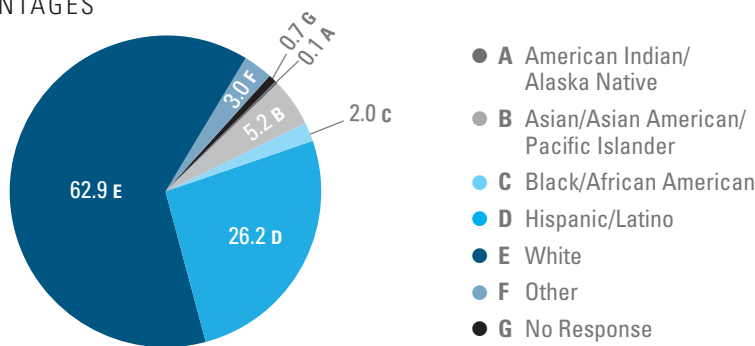

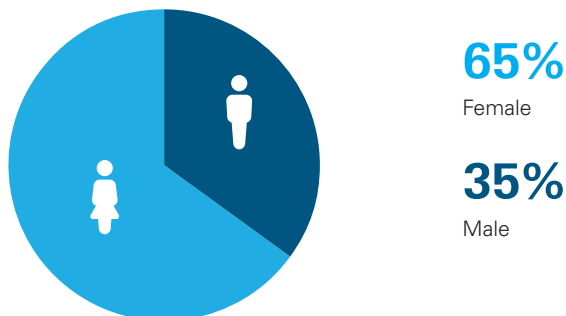

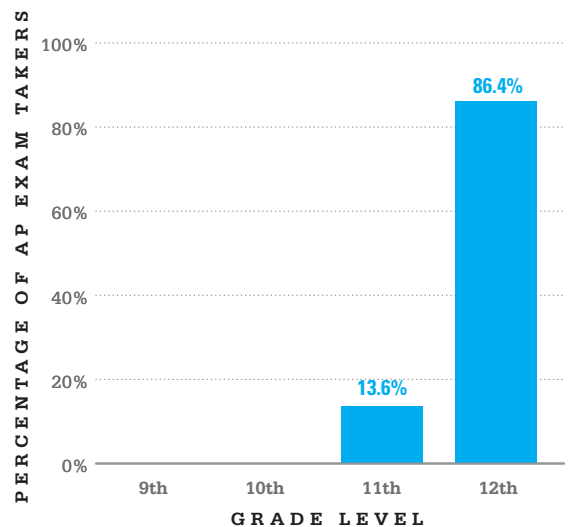
RACE/ETHNICITY PERCENTAGES
