# **Registration Information:**

Preconference workshops begin with breakfast at 7 a.m. on Thursday, July 14 and conclude at 4 p.m.

The main conference begins on Thursday, July 14, at 5 p.m. with the opening plenary session, followed by the welcome reception at 6:30 p.m., and concludes on Saturday, July 16, at 4 p.m.

Postconference workshops begin with breakfast at 7 a.m. on Sunday, July 17, and conclude at 4 p.m.

The pre- and postconference workshops are limited to 30 attendees. Some workshops fill up quickly, and the College Board closes registration when capacity is reached, even if this occurs before the registration deadline. If your first-choice workshop is full, you'll be signed up for your second-choice workshop. In the event that both of your workshop choices are full, we will notify you in a timely manner.

**Main conference sessions** are open to all attendees on a first-come, first-served basis.
