**As of Dec. 11, 2010**, DANTES does not fund retesting on a previously funded CLEP exam. However, service members may personally fund a retest after waiting six months.

Each college sets its own policy regarding which CLEP exams it will grant credit for and how many credits it will award. Contact your admission officer or academic adviser to learn more about the CLEP policy at your institution.
