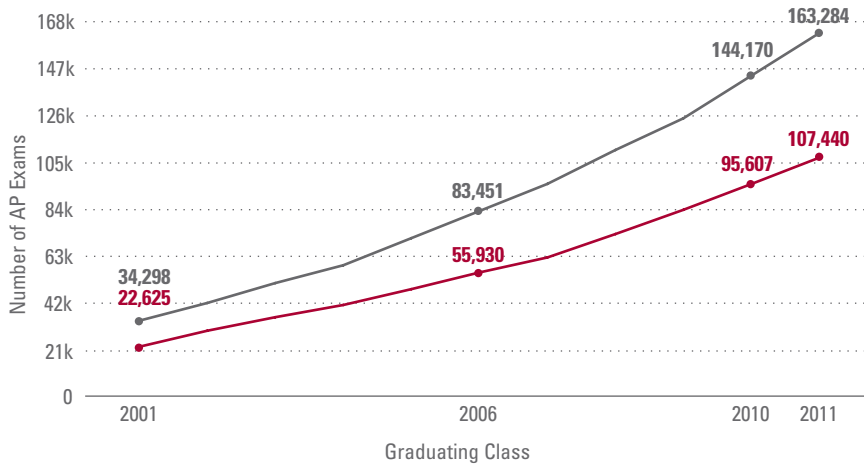

- Taken by graduates at any point in high school scoring 3+



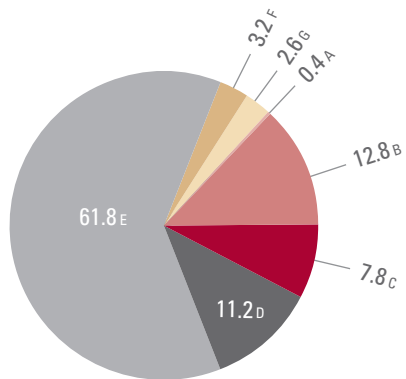

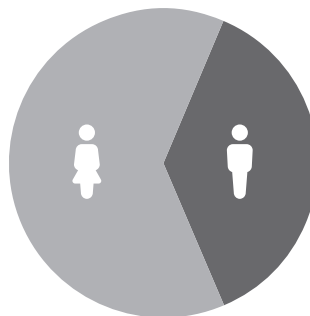

- G No Response

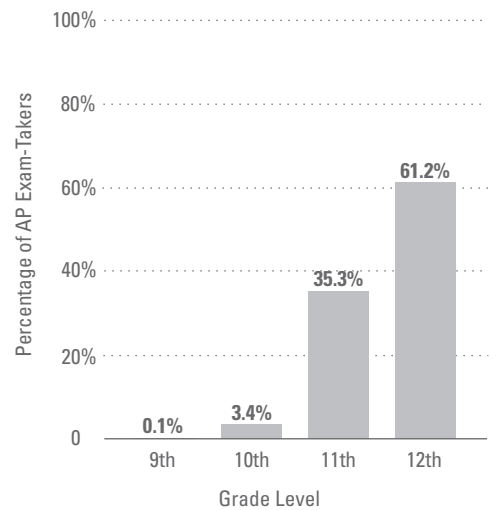
