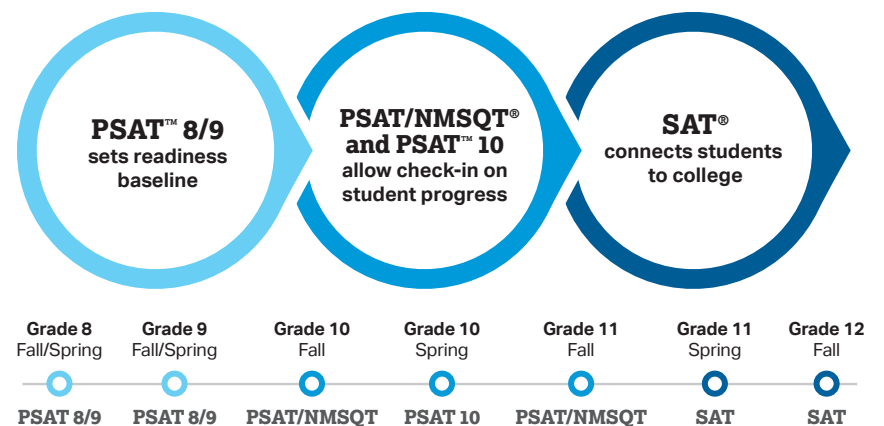
SAT SUITE OF ASSESSMENTS CROSS-REFERENCE GUIDE



With the recent expansion of SAT[®] School Day, schools can now order the SAT and administer it to any number of students. With SAT School Day, the SAT is delivered in school, on a regular school day, like the PSAT-related assessments. Schools can order any of the entire SAT Suite of Assessments—the SAT, PSAT/NMSQT[®], PSAT[™] 10, and PSAT[™] 8/9—in one place, with the ability to test multiple grades and administer multiple tests on the same day.

Schools administer the SAT differently across weekend and SAT School Day testing, so we've created this reference guide to help you better understand how the SAT Suite of Assessments can work best for your school.
