

# SAT Subject Tests<sup>™</sup> Subscore Percentile Ranks

## 2016–2018 Graduating Classes

These percentiles allow you to compare a student's subscores with those of other takers of the particular SAT Subject Test. The percentile rank shows students the percentage of test takers from the past three graduating classes who earned a lower subscore than they did.

When viewing the subscores below, please keep in mind that the influence of each subscore on the final 200–800-point score varies from test to test, depending on how many items of each type are included.

Also note that subscores are not comparable across tests because the population of students varies from one test to the next.
